# **Importance of Getting Involved**

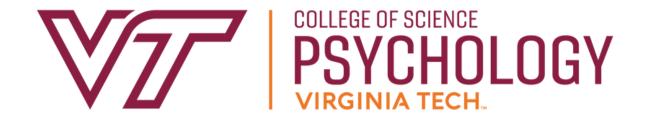
