

Course Registration Instructions

Fall 2024

Course Registration has Two Phases

Phase 1:
Course Request
March 19 – April 2, 2024

- Course Request allows you to tell VT what you would like to take
 - This process also helps department determine if they need to add more sections of a course
- Courses are not automatically awarded so you are **not guaranteed** to get the courses you request

Phase 2:
Drop Add
April 19 – May 24, 2024

- Drop/Add is “live action,” and this is where you can finalize your class schedule
- During drop/add you will add courses you may not have gotten through course request and/or change sections of courses if there are seats

Preparing for Course Request

First

Take care of any holds on your account. You cannot submit course request if you have a hold which affects registration

To check for holds go to Hokie Spa →
Hokie Wallet → Administrative Holds

Second: What do you need to take?

First Year Students (including first-year transfer): Review your academic plan you created in PSYC 1024 or PSYC 2024.

[Run a DARs Report](#), you can run a DARs report to view the courses you have remaining.

2024 Graduates: [Apply for your Degree](#) before running your DARs. This is the only way to get an accurate DARs report

If you entered VT in 2023 or later, view this document [here](#) and compare it to your DARs report

Third

Make a list of the courses you plan to enroll in for Fall 2024

Fourth

Review the [timetable](#), when it's available, to select specific sections of your courses. Make sure to check for:

- Schedule conflicts
- Pre-requisites

Write down the CRNs for all of your desired courses
