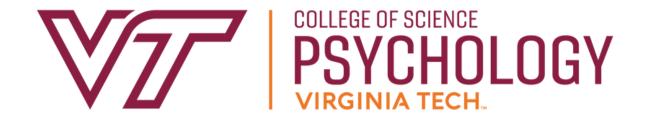

## **Utilize Professors and Academic Advisors**

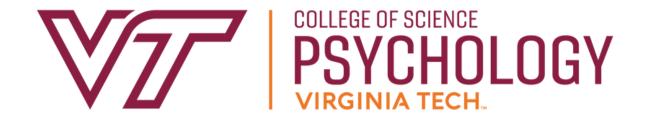

## **Utilize Professors and Office Hours Effectively**

Have a clear purpose for using Office Hours so your time is used well.

- During your meeting:
  - Take Notes
  - $\circ\;$  Ask for further explanation if it doesn't make sense
  - Be honest if you are not fully understanding
  - Sum up your action plan at the end of the meeting
