  - Self-regulation, self-system, religiousness/spirituality, and prosocial motivation/behavior as protective mechanisms in resilience development
  - Socioenvironmental factors contributing to resilience (parenting, peer relationships, social support)
- Risky Decision Making and Health Risk Behaviors
  - Developmental trajectories of emotional/motivational processes (e.g., risk/reward sensitivity) and cognitive control processes (executive functioning, delay discounting) contributing to adolescent and young adult health risk behaviors (substance use and risky sexual behaviors).
